American Amateur Soccer League (AASL)  
and  
Northern Ohio Girls Soccer League (NOGSL)  
Fall 2011 / Spring 2011**

The Midview Soccer League would like to take this opportunity to invite new and existing players to our annual tryouts for the AASL & NOGSL 2011/2012 (Fall / Spring) seasons. Try-outs for age groups U9 and above and will be held at the Midview Soccer League Complex (16200 Chamberlain Rd.) located south of the Grafton Village on the following dates:

**Friday, June 10th, 2011 - 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm**

**Saturday, June 11th, 2011 - 10:00 am to 1:00 pm**

The AASL is a competitive league for players looking to develop their skills and play against the best players from surrounding communities. AASL participation is also an excellent way to develop at an early age for future High School or College play. This is predominantly a boys league that permits co-ed players. The NOGSL is a competitive girls only league that has the same objectives as above, but consists of girls only teams. NOGSL players may also "Double Card" (play in other leagues) as well. (for more information, go to: [nogsl.com](http://nogsl.com))

Most AASL & NOGSL games are played on Sunday afternoons and schedules are posted on the leagues web site for all age groups.

Try-outs will be open to all current and new players in the U-9 to U-14 age groups. Current players are required to participate in try-outs if they wish to retain a spot on their teams roster and new players have an opportunity to showcase their skills for new teams and open positions. Plan to spend one hour with the coaches.

We are looking for the most dedicated and skilled players in each age group with the desire, willingness and seriousness to learn and play at the next level. Try-outs will allow each player to demonstrate their skill in one-on-one situations (individual ability) as well as small-sided game situations (team awareness skill level). Coaches will be evaluating every participant in multiple skill areas in order to rank each players ability.

Once the try-outs are completed the coaching staff will review their evaluations and notify each player (approximately 1 - 2 weeks after) if he or she has been placed on a team roster. (Trying out for a team does not guarantee a spot on the roster since the leagues rules limit the roster size.)
